- The AP exam is required for all Bishop students
- The exam will be taken online.
- Each student will receive a log in from College Board.
- The exam is 45 minutes in length.
- Students who receive accommodations will receive those same accommodations for the online AP exam.
- The exam is a modification of information completed up to March 13, or by unit. (See https://apcoronavirusupdates.collegeboard.org/students for additional information)
- The test will be open book/open note. There will be no multiple-choice questions.
- Beginning late April, College Board will offer simulation test practice.
- Teachers will share course specific instructions.
- College have committed to awarding credit for 2020 AP dependent upon the score.
- The fee remains \$94. Please contact Mrs. Gehling if a fee adjustment is needed. The deadline to submit waivers to College Board is April 30th.
