It's been wonderful to have everyone back on campus after the Christmas break. During the month of December, the Bishop community celebrated the success of our men's and women's basketball teams at the annual HAECO tournament at the Greensboro Coliseum. We had an outstanding turnout of students, parents and faculty to cheer on the Villains as they competed against a



number of schools from Guilford County. The Lady Villains took second place in the championship game!

I want to thank everyone who gave to our 1959 Fund during our December match challenge. We raised nearly \$20,000 (surpassing our goal for the month!) and have collected close to \$35,000 for the current school year. We are confident we will meet our annual target of \$160,000 by year's end, all of which supports this year's operating budget.

Together with the net proceeds of over \$75,000 from our November gala, the ongoing generosity of our parents, alumni, and friends makes it possible for us to live out our mission of forming students to live and serve in a world in need of peace, love, and justice.










Tuition Assistance / Financial Aid Information

We recognize the financial commitment and investment made by families who pursue a Bishop education. To support our families, we offer needbased tuition assistance and also accept the NC Opportunity Scholarship. The Opportunity Scholarship program has undergone recent changes that will expand the access to scholarship funds to more families for the 2024-2025 school year. Due to these changes, all families applying for tuition assistance through Bishop McGuinness will be required to first apply for the Opportunity Scholarship. Tuition assistance will only be awarded after we have received notice of scholarship award amounts and any other assistance awarded from third parties.

Driver Eligibility Information

When your student is ready to go to the DMV to get his/her permit, a parent will need to call The School Office to request an official transcript and Driver Eligibility Certificate.

Please allow 48 hours notice to process any transcript requests.

A parent must bring the student's Driver's Ed Completion Certificate to The School Office and sign the Driver Eligibility Certificate. The Driver Eligibility Form is good for 30 daysonce it has been signed. Please keep this in mind when making plans to go to the DMV.

The DMV is now requiring official transcripts as a proof of residency. Please contact the front office at 336-564-1010 to make this request.

Driver's Ed is offered through the NC Driving School. You can visit www.ncdrivingschool.com for instructions to sign up. North Carolina requires that Driver's Ed be taken in the county of the high school. (i.e. Bishop McGuinness is in Forsyth county. If you live in Guilford county, you must take Driver's Ed in Forsyth county.) You can sign up on their website at one of the public high schools. You may choose to do private Driver's Ed, which may be completed in any county.
