MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT

Dear Bishop McGuinness Families,

As we enter the final stretch of Lent and look ahead to Holy Week, I was reflecting on the themes explored in a recent episode of *The Trinity Forum* podcast titled "The Blessing of Limitations." The episode focuses on how limitations—so often seen as obstacles—can instead be gifts that shape our character,



deepen our relationships, and point us toward our need for one another and for God. They remind us that embracing our limits is not a sign of weakness, but rather an invitation to depend on grace, to work collaboratively, and to grow in humility. At Bishop, this perspective invites us to view the boundaries of our time, energy, and

capacity not as deficits, but as opportunities to cultivate compassion, community, and creativity.

In our school community, we can all too easily miss seeing these blessings unfold daily. Whether it's a student learning to ask for help, a teacher adapting to the needs of a classroom, or a team or cast pulling together to overcome a challenge, our limitations are often the very things that draw us into deeper connection with each other. They remind us that we are not meant to walk alone. As a Catholic school, we believe that God meets us most powerfully in our moments of need—and that within those limits, He can reveal a path forward filled with purpose and hope.

This message takes on even deeper meaning as we prepare to accompany Christ in His Passion next week. Holy Week invites us to walk closely with Jesus as He embraces suffering, rejection, and ultimately death—not because He is powerless, but because He chooses to enter fully into our human limitations. In doing so, He transforms them. The Cross becomes not an end, but the prerequisite to Resurrection. As we gather as a school community for Mass, reflections, and prayer next week, may we remember that to share in Christ's Resurrection, we must also accompany Him in His suffering—with courage, compassion, and love.

Let us walk through the upcoming Holy Week together, not as people trying to escape our limitations, but as a school community open to how God might work through them to bring about new life.







Immunization Records

Each student must have a current, COMPLETE Immunization Record on file. (PLEASE INCLUDE ALL PAGES OF THE RECORD)

Rising Seniors, Class of 2025, are required to have two (2) doses of the Meningococcal conjugate.

All new students (rising Freshmen and Transfer Students) must also have an Immunization Record on file.

Please *DO NOT* upload the immunization records to FinalForms.

Driver Eligibility Information

When your student is ready to go to the DMV to get his/her permit, a parent will need to call The School Office to request an official transcript and Driver Eligibility Certificate.

Please allow 48 hours notice to process any transcript requests.

A parent must bring the student's Driver's Ed Completion Certificate to The School Office and sign the Driver Eligibility Certificate. The Driver Eligibility Form is good for 30 days once it has been signed. Please keep this in mind when making plans to go to the DMV.

The DMV is now requiring official transcripts as a proof of residency. Please contact the front office at 336-564-1010 to make this request.

Driver's Ed is offered through the NC Driving School. You can visit www.ncdrivingschool.com for instructions to sign up. North Carolina requires that Driver's Ed be taken in the county of the high school. (i.e. Bishop McGuinness is in Forsyth county. If you live in Guilford county, you must take Driver's Ed in Forsyth county.) You can sign up on their website at one of the public high schools. You may choose to do private Driver's Ed, which may be completed in any county.
