#### MESSAGE FROM OUR CHAPLAIN

Dear Bishop McGuinness Families,

We are greatly saddened to learn of the death of our dear Pope Francis. As we mourn his passing, let us remember to pray for the repose of his soul, for the Church during this time of transition, and for the man who will be appointed as his successor. The day before Pope Francis' passing, the Church joyfully celebrated Easter Sunday;



may Pope Francis be quickly welcomed into the joy of the Lord, and come to share in the promise of the resurrection.

The passing of a pope marks the beginning of an interesting period in the life of the Church, as the Church prepares for someone new to take the office of the papacy. This process takes place within what is known as a "conclave," which is a meeting of the cardinals from around the world. The cardinals will come to Rome and meet privately to discuss who the next pope should be, and when they are ready, they will have a vote. There can be multiple votes during the conclave as the cardinals continue their deliberations. Once the cardinals have agreed, the decision will be announced, and the Church will have her next pope. We should remember to pray for the cardinals as they enter into the conclave, that they would be open to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, and that God's will would be done in the choosing of the next pope.

Once more, in the days to come, let us remember to keep Pope Francis in our prayers. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him! May his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.







Rising Seniors, Class of 2025, are required to have two (2) doses of the Meningococcal conjugate.

All new students (rising Freshmen and Transfer Students) must also have an Immunization Record on file.

#### **Driver Eligibility Information**

When your student is ready to go to the DMV to get his/her permit, a parent will need to call The School Office to request an official transcript and Driver Eligibility Certificate.

Please allow 48 hours notice to process any transcript requests.

A parent must bring the student's Driver's Ed Completion Certificate to The School Office and sign the Driver Eligibility Certificate. The Driver Eligibility Form is good for 30 daysonce it has been signed. Please keep this in mind when making plans to go to the DMV.

The DMV is now requiring official transcripts as a proof of residency. Please contact the front office at 336-564-1010 to make this request.

Driver's Ed is offered through the NC Driving School. You can visit www.ncdrivingschool.com for instructions to sign up. North Carolina requires that Driver's Ed be taken in the county of the high school. (i.e. Bishop McGuinness is in Forsyth county. If you live in Guilford county, you must take Driver's Ed in Forsyth county.) You can sign up on their website at one of the public high schools. You may choose to do private Driver's Ed, which may be completed in any county.
