- 2. If you have a previous account under a different email address, you will need to update it to be your BMHS email address.
 - Login in to your Delta Math account
 - Go to Tools
 - Select Login/School Information
 - Go to Personal/Login Information
 - Click edit
 - Update your email address
 - Save
- 4. Now that your account is updated, follow any instructions provided by Delta Math to verify your email address (if applicable).
- 5. Once you have finished, login with your email and password you created to work on your summer assignment.

If you already have a Delta Math account with your BMHS email, follow these steps:
