If you're **new to Delta Math**:

1. Go to [this link](#).
2. Click **“Register with Email”** and use your **BMHS email address**.
3. Follow the steps to verify your account and create your password.
4. Be sure to use your **legal first and last name**.
5. Once registered, log in and begin your work. Keep your password somewhere safe!

If you **already have a Delta Math account**:
