It is time for us to begin the process of enrollment/registration for the 2020-2021 school year. In the last month all of our lives have changed drastically, but through it all Bishop McGuinness has been here for your student(s) and your family. We realize the future remains unclear, but want you to be reassured your student will be able to receive a quality Catholic education from Bishop McGuinness.

**In light of the economic repercussions of COVID-19, Bishop McGuinness is freezing tuition for the 2020-2021 school year.** A revised schedule of tuition and fees is included with this email.

We are moving to FACTS tuition management for the 2020-2021 school year. For us to prepare for the next school year, we need our families to go to Family Portal and "Enroll" their student(s) as well as input your payment options for the 2020-2021 school year. This can be found under "Family". Please note you must complete the "enrollment packet" before you can fill out the financial information. The timing of this is not ideal, but this new tuition management system will give our families more flexibility than our current system. Please take a few moments to complete these steps by May 18, 2020. As you can understand, our enrollment numbers are critical to the overall budget of our school.

Bishop McGuinness continues to strive to provide assistance to families to ensure Catholic education is affordable for all. The application deadline for Affordability/Financial Assistance **was** April 1, 2020. While available funds are limited, if you feel you may need assistance for the upcoming year please apply.
